## FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This past weekend close to 40 women of our parish participated in the ACTS retreat for women at the Marianist Retreat Center in Eureka. The retreat is a culmination of many weeks of preparation by the members of the team, and I would like to take this opportunity to thank them for their hard work. It is through their efforts that participants on the ACTS retreats for both men and women open their hearts to the love of Christ in their lives. If you are interested in the next ACTS retreat please call the rectory and we will have someone contact you.

It was great to welcome to our Sunday 12 Noon Mass members of our parish's Girl Scout Troop. Most recently the scouts of our parish were helping out at our parish Fish Fry by busing and cleaning tables, and helping to serve desserts. Their bright smiling faces brought joy to so many who took part in the dinner. Many thanks to their leaders for their strong dedication to the girls.

Beginning on Monday, March 20th, work will commence in our gym to repair the wall damaged by a recent accident. On Monday they will build a temporary wall inside the gym and enclose the area around the damaged wall. Between Monday and Friday the lower part of the wall below the window line will be removed and rebuilt. The current plan calls for the major portion of the work to be completed by Friday and the temporary wall removed. This will enable the Variety Guild to come in on Saturday, the 25th of March, and complete the setup of their stage. The HVAC unit will be replaced after the wall is installed.

I wanted also to take a moment to follow-up with you in regard to the water break in our concession stand. The damaged water pipes have been replaced. The ceiling damaged by the water intrusion has been replaced, along with all new wiring and lighting in the affected areas. All repairs are covered under our insurance policy, so the only out-of-pocket expense for us is the deductible, which is \$2,500. The next step will be to do a thorough cleaning of the stand and get it up and ready for the beginning of the baseball/softball season.

There are two areas for our Sunday Liturgy that I would like for you to think about getting more involved. We are in need of a few more Eucharistic Ministers and Ministers of Hospitality. If you are interested, or would like more information, please give a call to rectory. We will connect you with the correct person and then help get you trained. This is a great way to share your time and talent with others.
